
Barrier legislation dictactes that all barriers must conform to the following standards:

BS 8442:2006 - The British Standard

The Red Book - Safety at Street Works & Road Works

Chapter 8 - The Traffic Signs Manual

TSRGD - Traffic Signs Regulations & General Directions



Other Points:

Chapter 8 states that:

"Tubular Steel poles shall not be used as horizontal Barriers as they constitue a serious hazard."

BS 8442:2006 identifies three wind speeds and a calculation for the Ballast required to use in these wind speeds.
